## nosh on this

By day, guests will enjoy cooling off with a beverage at Nosh, a new and more modern swim-up bar concept with a second level that serves sunset bites (and views) by night. Patrons can expect locally inspired "chilled" cuisine such as fresh tostadas piled high with bay-caught seafood.

## inspired rooms and suites


The completion of the new pool and Nosh caps off a series of renovations that began in 2017, and include renovations to the resort's 433 upscale, ocean-facing guest rooms and suites. Think calming blue and sand tones and splashes of colorful accents. Bathrooms have also been transformed with new glass showers for a more modern chic beach retreat feel.

# open air lobby

The lobby entrance - now an open-air layout - offers a playful contemporary vibe complete with swinging pods from where to take in views of the bay and mountains beyond. Treat yourself with a cone (or cup) from the new Blue Bell ice cream parlor. While you may be tempted to stay there all day, don't miss....

## ceviche and tequila bar

...boasting an impressive wall of 180 different tequilas that pair well with a fresh and creative approach on ceviche. A few steps closer to the ocean, you'll spot a raised pool deck area with cocoon daybeds and a poolside Coco Bar serving fresh chilled coconut water and cocktails.


the suite life

## champions sports bar


Catch the "big game" with all-American fare. Must Try: Cheese fries with a cold Modelo Especial, a local fave!


#### mikado

# Tequila Education Program

Learn the history of this popular Mexican spirit with a proper tasting. Marriott Puerto Vallarta grows its own blue agave on property in the cactus garden, and is one of only a few resorts in the world with a proprietary brand of tequila. Its five varieties include: *blanco*, *joven*, *reposado*, *añejo* and *extra añejo*.

meet andrey

Authentic Mexican tequila, such as the CasaMagna tequila, is made to be "sipped" in order to savor the flavor. An art form that requires the proper training, the resort offers the expertise of Audrey Formisano, Tequilier, who hosts weekly tastings in La Cava wine cellar. The program was developed to educate guests in the name of good, Mexican tequila.

If you're a Marriott Rewards member, you can enjoy the experience on the house, otherwise the cost is \$15 USD. Additionally, the resort offers more than 60 brands, with 180 different tequilas by the glass




La Familia


activity center

sea turtle rescue program

Between June and November, biologists commissioned by Marriott comb the beaches to preserve and protect sea turtle nesting areas. Since the program started, more than 4,000 nests have been incubated at the hotel's nursery, and over 1,200 incubated naturally at the beach. This is a family favorite. Children staying at the resort have the chance to name their tiny sea turtles, gather at sunset with their families to wish them luck and set them free to return to the ocean.

jalisco at your table

The hotel's executive chef and kitchen staff put their heads and palates together to develop a special, seven-course "Jalisco at your Table' menu with recipes inspired by their childhoods and time spent in their mothers' and abuelas' kitchens. From the pillowy tamale to authentic Birria tacos, this culinary homage to the state of Jalisco is a delicious add-on for travelers hungry to take a bite out of the local culture.

Every Friday and Saturday morning, a local fisherman drops off a cooler of the days fresh catch and brings it to the chef. The chef lays out the offerings on ice, where guests pick their fish of choice for dinner.



#### GET THERE

Puerto Vallarta's international airport (Licenciado Gustavo Díaz Ordaz International Airport) is served by 12 major airlines including Aeromexico, Alaska Airlines, WestJet, American Airlines, Continental Airlines, Delta Airlines, US Airways, United and Virgin America, with direct flights from major US cities including Atlanta, Chicago, Dallas, Denver, Detroit, Houston, Los Angeles, Las Vegas, Minneapolis, New York City, Oakland, Portland, Saint Louis, Salt Lake City, San Diego, San Jose, San Francisco, Orange County, and Seattle.

#### DO

- For friends of the water: deep-sea fishing, boat tours to Las Caletas (a private cove for swimming), Marietas Island for snorkeling.
- For the adventurous type: jungle canopy zip-line tours, ATV jungle treks, hiking, biking and horseback riding.
- For the culture seekers: join in on the seasonal celebrations of Dia de los Muertos and the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe.
- For the animal lover: birding tours to spot 355 different species, humpback whale watching (Nov. April).
- For the foodies: take a street eats tour through downtown Puerto Vallarta.
